



**Project Title: 0102– Basic Infrastructure Building in the Cantonment Sites (Roads Sub Project)**

**Name of Implementing Agency:** Division Road Offices (DROs) of the Department of Roads, Ministry of Physical Planning Works

**Status:** Completed

**Duration:** December 2006- July 2007

**Location:** 2 cantonment sites: Chitwan (Chitwan) and Illam (Ilam)

**Beneficiaries:** Maoists combatants and 50 thousand people living in the vicinity of the road

**Budget:** NPR 40 Million

**Description:**

This is a sub-project that aims to construct access roads to the cantonments (Causeway). The Cantonment Management Central Coordinator's Office (CMCCO) is mainly responsible to coordinate implementation of this project whereas the Department of Roads, Ministry of Physical Planning and Work has carried out the implementation of this sub project.

**Summary of Achievements:**

The access roads to cantonment sub project were completed as per plan constructing four causeways in two cantonments (Chitwan and Illam).

**Outcomes:**

- Improved socio-economic activities in the local areas nearby cantonments.
- Improved road connectivity in and around cantonment area leading to improved access for local residents.
- Improved monitoring of cantonments leading to improved facilities and services in the cantonments.
