

Project Title: 0112 - Cantonment Health Management Programme Phase II

Objectives:

The objectives are as follows:

- To run a primary health care facility at each main cantonment with full staff including a medical doctor.
- To run one first aid post in each satellite cantonment with trained health workers.
- Provide medical checkups and free medical treatment to the combatants in the main and satellite cantonments.
- Manage patient referrals to higher hospitals as needed.
- Manage emergencies at sites.

Summary of Achievements:

The progress made significantly exceeds the physical targets set for health services.

- Treatment and referral of health care services (no): 1,605
- Medical check-up of combatants (no): 152,299
- Medical check-up of local people (no): 179,528

Outcomes:

- Institutionalization of improved health care facilities at cantonment locality.
- Improved free health care facilities for combatants and neighbours.
- Cordial relation has been established between neighbours and combatants.

Issues:

- Inadequate medicines to meet the demand of combatants and the neighbouring communities.
- Unavailability of doctors and health officers.
- Health care facilities are not internalized by the government.
