



**Project Title: 0202 - Rehabilitation Center at BPKIHS Dharan**

**Description:**

- Needs of conflict-disabled victims are wide ranging that has to be addressed through implementation of a comprehensive rehabilitation package. Rehabilitation of conflict-disabled victims is often a complex process requiring a holistic approach supported by adequate level of technical and financial resources. To address this, the project was proposed to establish and develop a rehabilitation center (RC) at BPKIHS as a center of excellence in rehabilitation of people who have lost parts of their body during conflict and are exposed to extreme hardships in their life. The activities include long term psychosocial counseling for victims who need it, fostering socio-economic transformation and interest based activities, while engaging with other partners to ensure that victim's needs are catered to.

**Goal:**

- Improved quality of life of the conflict affected people (CAP) with disabilities through rehabilitation and development of their abilities for better integration.

**Purpose:**

- To establish the facilities and extend quality services on physical, psychological, occupational and vocational rehabilitation of CAPs with disabilities

**Expected Outputs:**

- A well equipped RC building constructed
- RC/BPKIHS staff trained on rehabilitation aspects to provide services to CAPs with disability
- Increased access of conflict affected people with disabilities to rehabilitation services.

**Note:** *as the project is at the initial implementation stages, the outcomes and issues are not yet evident.*
