Goal:

To ensure elections free, fair and faultless and promote democratic values through consolidating the voting right of the eligible people across the country

Purpose:

Facilitate an update of the Electoral Roll that will include all eligible voters.

Description of the project:

The project, CVRPP is designed to collect, register and update the voter's list with photograph to ensure free, fair and faultless elections and the democratic values in the country. This project is a part of the Multi-year Strategic Plan (2008/9- 2012/13), and stepping on the plan the program of registering the voter list with photograph began in 2010 which was supposed to complete by June, 2011 but has been delayed due to unavoidable political circumstances. Therefore, the CVRPP is designed to register all the eligible people who missed in the former main phase of the program.

Outcomes: Yet to emerge as the project is in initial stages of implementation.

Expected Outputs:

Output 1 - Electronic voter registration process enhanced and implemented;
Output 2- Voter education and outreach supports the electronic voter registration process; and
Output 3 - Effective planning, monitoring and record keeping system operating within central and district level.
