Budget: NRs. 4,756,493,210

Brief Description:

Since the Government of Nepal has declared the next constituent assembly elections for 19 November 2013, the Election Commission of Nepal has to do all the preparatory and managerial works for the elections with a vivid vision of making it free, fair, credible and efficient. In this course, ECN has drafted this project particularly for the effective preparation and the successful management of the elections. This project under its six outputs primarily includes major activities such as production of the final voter roll, capacity building of human resources for elections, deployment of the officials, procurement and management of logistics in elections and conduction of the polling that are significant and crucial to overall election management.

Goal:

Ensure free, fair and credible elections for inclusive democracy.

Purpose:

To manage free, fair and credible Constituent Assembly election in 2013

Output:

1. Improved institutional capacity of the ECN
2. Final voter roll is produced before election, updating the old data and incorporating the new registration of all the eligible voters
3. Increased electoral education and information for voters for their decisive participation and correct way of polling
4. Polling and other officials are mobilized during elections
5. Election is managed effectively
6. Enhanced election validation and learning
